Lotus Preschool

It was a longtime dream that we could serve the pupils a free daily breakfast. The children who come to attend classes at LOTUS CHILDREN CENTER are from the surrounding slum at Sukura. We have seen that when they are hungry they find it harder to focus in the classes. Some of the pupils don't take food in the morning, some take a poor carbohydrate meal such as white bread and sweetened tea because their parents can't afford to pay for nutritious meals for them.



We implemented this program soon as the classes started in January. We managed to run this mass feeding program for the 30 pupils of LOTUS PRESCHOOL every weekday! It was successful as well stressful as I never knew how I would be able to get enough groceries for the week and the inflation this year was merciless. This program was accomplished only by His grace.

Esther, a neighbor, was a pioneer who took the initiative to approach her friends and colleges trying to get some donation to Lotus Children Home. So, different people brought food items such as tin tomatoes, rice, spaghetti, oil, etc. Inspired by Esther, I requested support in cash or kind from all my contacts as the wish of my 10th anniversary in Ghana. Many responded and supported the daily breakfast program going on! 

What we have achieved with your contribution for these 6 months of free breakfast program:



Our pupils got access to nutritious food which helps them to grow healthy.



When they get a fulfilling meal in the morning, they become more attentive in their studies through the day.



The parents got relieved from the stress of having to feed their kids in the morning.



The appreciation for the local food: Ghanaian food is very nutritious –made of millet, plantain, brown rice, roots, groundnuts, maize, etc. Yet, many are replacing their traditional meals by the Western fast food. By feeding our pupils delicious local food, we are educating them and their parents to value it.

FINALLY! The gutter has been installed on the front of PATH OF JOY CHILDREN'S CENTER (Kasoa) solving the problem with sanitation. Since 2015 we have endured the dirty water and muddy at the entrance of our Children's Center.



The initiative started by sister Abhaya from Italy, who heard about the project from Indradeva, a volunteer who worked in the Center.

She fundraised and we could complete the first phase of the project. However, we needed much more funds to supply the gutter sections. Fortunately, NAWA (North American Women Association) extended the helping hand.

It was thrilling to see the place so neat for the first time in these 10 years I have been working there.

Now the children are safer when entering the place and have a clean and nicer environment to learn and play!

ACTIVITIES

Our brothers and sisters from the Stockholm unit gave a donation which went to reactivate the library. Therefore, in these August holidays, the community kids are having exciting extracurricular activities, such as yoga, drumming, and local dance, gardening, recycling papers into crafts, and, of course, a lot of playing! Besides, each child who comes to participate in the Language Arts reinforcements gets an English workbook.
